# **RETAIL SALES: UNITED STATES**

#### 1.1 The U.S. Retail Sector

The U.S. retail industry encompasses more than 1.6 million retail establishments and employs more than 24 million people (about 1 in 5 American workers), according to the National Retail Federation (NRF, <a href="https://www.nrf.com">www.nrf.com</a>).

#### 1.2 Retail Sales

According to the Census Bureau (<u>www.census.gov</u>) of the U.S. Department of Commerce, total U.S. retail sales were \$5.75 trillion in 2017, a 4.2% gain from 2016. Sales at GAFO (general merchandise, apparel, furnishings, and other) stores were \$1.28 trillion in 2017, a 1.6% gain from 2016.
